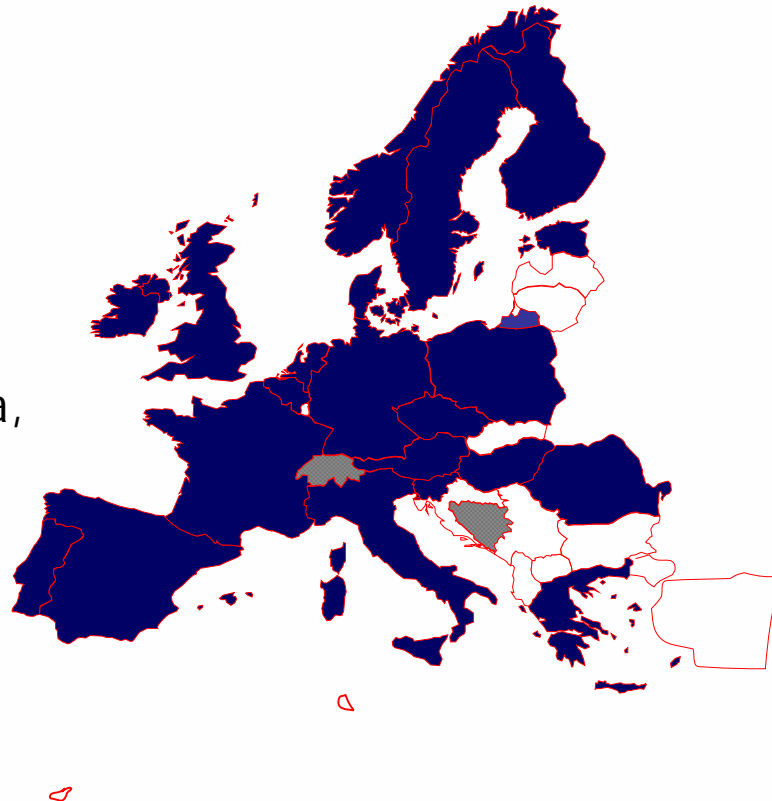
Constituent instruments

- **ENIAC (17):** Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Germany, Estonia, Hungary, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Sweden, United Kingdom



Membership

- Community + Member States + ARTEMISIA/AENEAS
 - Adhesion of new members:
 - Member States and Associated Countries: semi-automatic
 - Industry/research: through joining ARTEMISIA/AENEAS
 - Third Countries: Council agreement needed
 - Others
 - Calls are open to any organisation from Member States and Associated Countries
- ARTEMISIA / AENEAS
 - Membership is open to SMEs, Public Research Organisation and Corporate members (separate “Chambers”)
 - Associate status for individuals, legal persons that maintain an organisation of enterprises and/or Public Research Organisations that are active in the field of embedded systems and / or micro and nanoelectronics

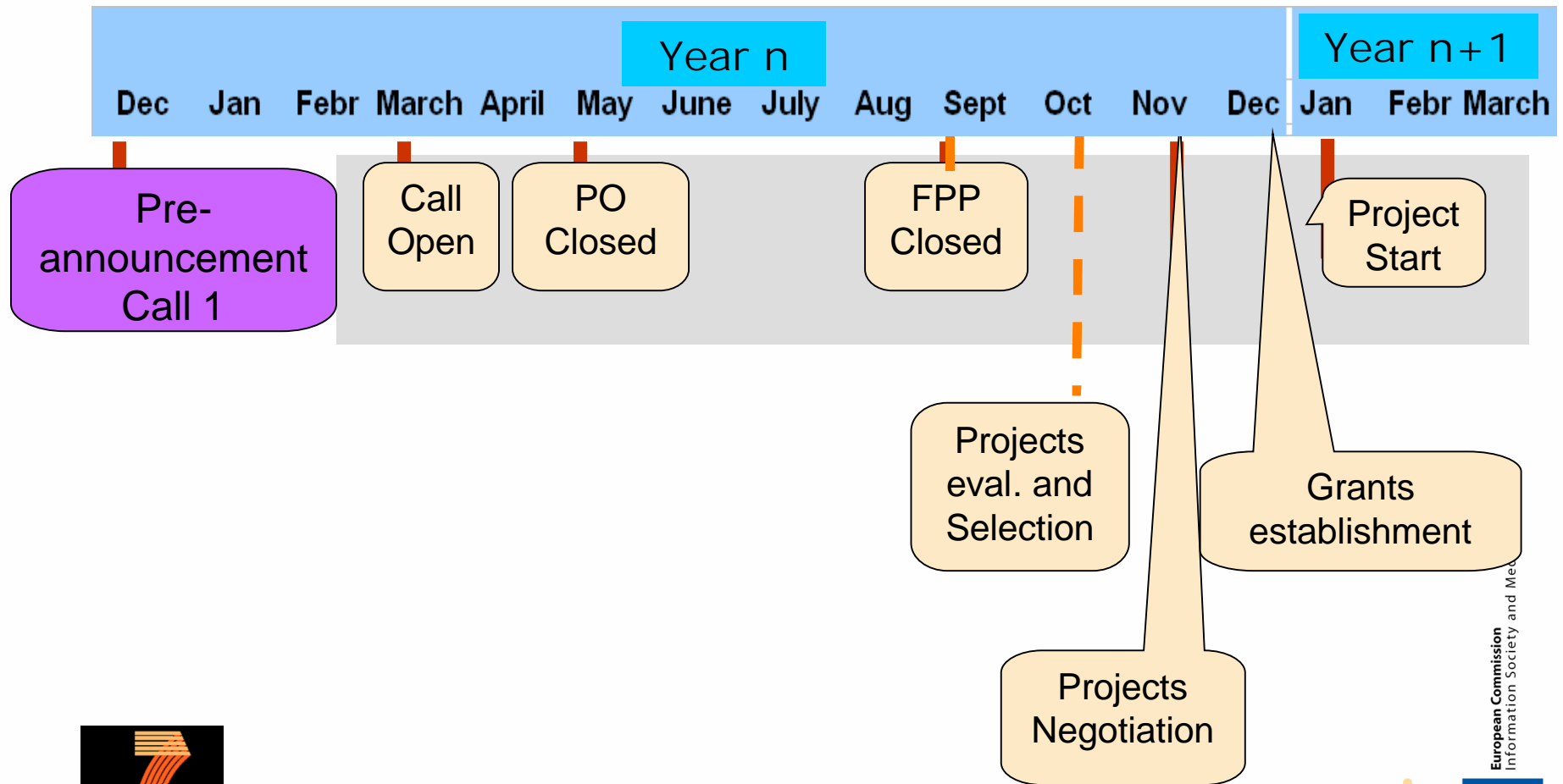

ARTEMIS/ENIAC research projects

- Industry-driven research projects in the field of Embedded Systems/Nanoelectronics
- Clearly defined and sharply focused objectives and approach
- At least three legal entities established in at least three different ARTEMIS/ENIAC Member States (collaborative research)
- Co-funding scheme, ARTEMIS/ENIAC Member States, ARTEMIS/ENIAC JU and in kind from the project participants



ARTEMIS/ENIAC financial rules

- Based on Commission Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 2343/2002 on the framework Financial Regulation for the bodies referred to in Article 185 of the Financial Regulation
- Derogations following the prior consent of the Commission on the basis of the specific operating needs of the JUs
- Adopted by the Governing Boards of the JUs



THE ARTEMIS/ENIAC GRANT AGREEMENT

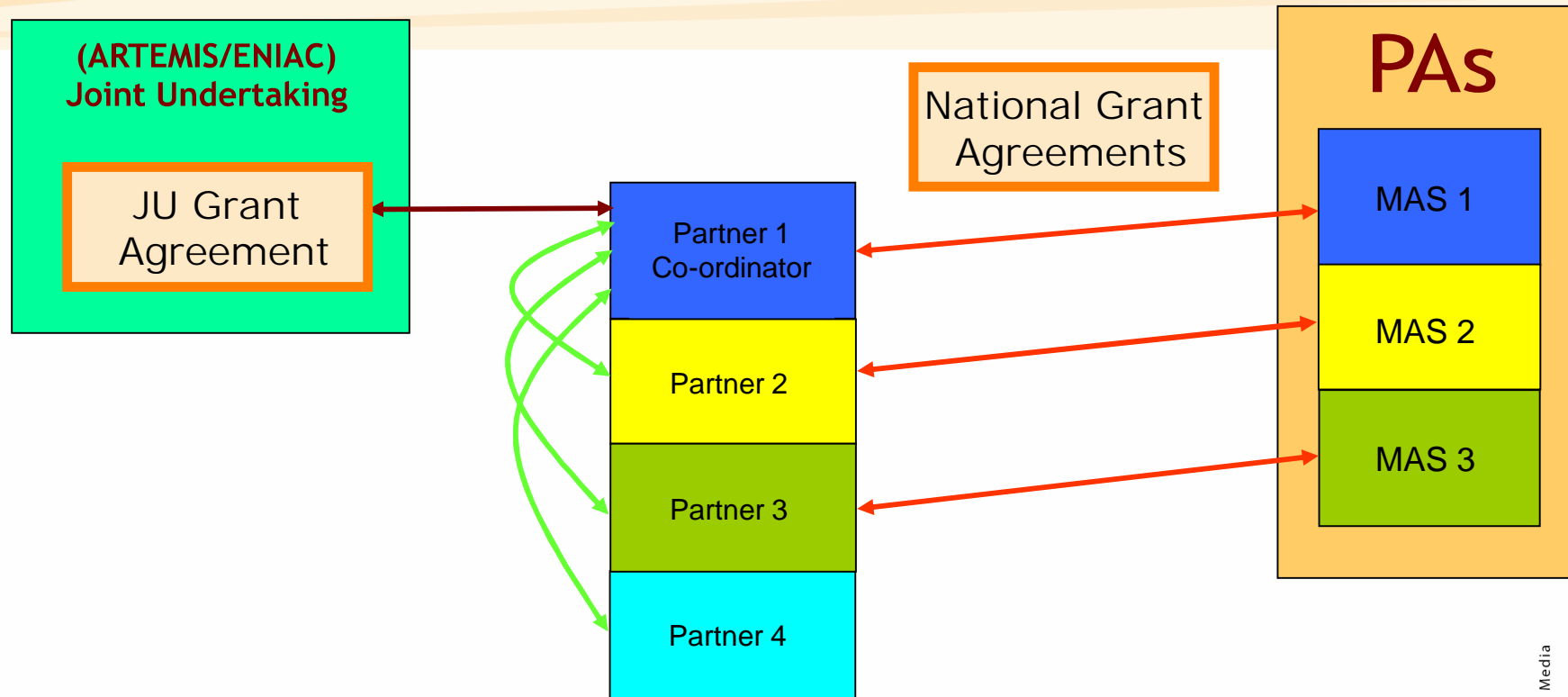


Eligibility for JU funding

- Legal entities established in ARTEMIS/ENIAC MS having concluded a corresponding national grant agreement following the award procedure of the JU
- Other legal entities established in MS or AC that are not members of the ARTEMIS/ENIAC JU



Grant agreement establishment



- Signature of National Grant Agreements
- Signature of JU Grant Agreement
- Accession to JU Grant Agreement



Basic Principles

- Follows the basic principles of the FP7 model grant agreement
- Signature by the coordinator
- Accession of other beneficiaries
- Mandatory Project agreement
- Collective technical responsibility
- No collective financial responsibility
- Funding disbursed directly to each beneficiary by the JU following the acceptance of the costs and, where applicable, the payment by the respective national funding authority



Structure

- General conditions applicable to all beneficiaries of a JU grant
- Specific conditions applicable to beneficiaries not having concluded a corresponding national grant agreement
- Specific conditions applicable to beneficiaries having concluded a corresponding national grant agreement



General conditions applicable to all beneficiaries of a JU grant -Annex II

- Organisation of the consortium and role of the coordinator
- Coordinator = technical coordinator
- Reporting and payments
- Suspension, confidentiality, recovery
 - No Guarantee Fund
- Financial and technical controls and audits
- IPR - see Council Regulations 74/2008 and 72/2008
- Amendments, termination, liability
- JU funding= 16.7% of the eligible costs



Specific conditions applicable to beneficiaries not having concluded a corresponding national grant agreement- Annex III (1)

For beneficiaries from MS and AC that are not Members of the ARTEMIS/ENIAC JU

- Provisions on financial reporting
- Certificate on the financial statements (CFS): mandatory for each beneficiary when its requested funding reaches 325,000 Euro (when cumulated with all previous payments for which a CFS has not been submitted)
- Payment modalities
- Subcontracting



Specific conditions applicable to beneficiaries not having concluded a corresponding national grant agreement- Annex III (2)

For beneficiaries from MS and AC that are not Members of the ARTEMIS/ENIAC JU

- Eligible costs
 - No certificate on the methodology
 - No average personnel costs
 - Indirect costs: flat-rate of 20% of direct costs minus subcontracting and third parties resources not used on the premises of the beneficiary



Specific conditions applicable to beneficiaries having concluded a corresponding national grant agreement- Annex IV (1)

Beneficiaries from ARTEMIS/ENIAC MS

- Terms and conditions on the eligibility of costs, pace of payment etc - reference to the corresponding national grant agreement
- Payment modalities: Payment by the JU following the notification to the JU by the respective national funding authority (NFA) of the acceptance of the costs and, where appropriate, of the payment of the national contribution



Specific conditions applicable to beneficiaries having concluded a corresponding national grant agreement- Annex IV (2)

Beneficiaries from ARTEMIS/ENIAC MS

- Subcontracting
 - Terms and conditions laid down by the respective NFA
- Eligible costs
 - Determined by the respective NFA
 - JU financial contribution determined by applying the upper funding limit (16.7%) to the eligible costs as defined by the respective NFA
 - VAT not eligible



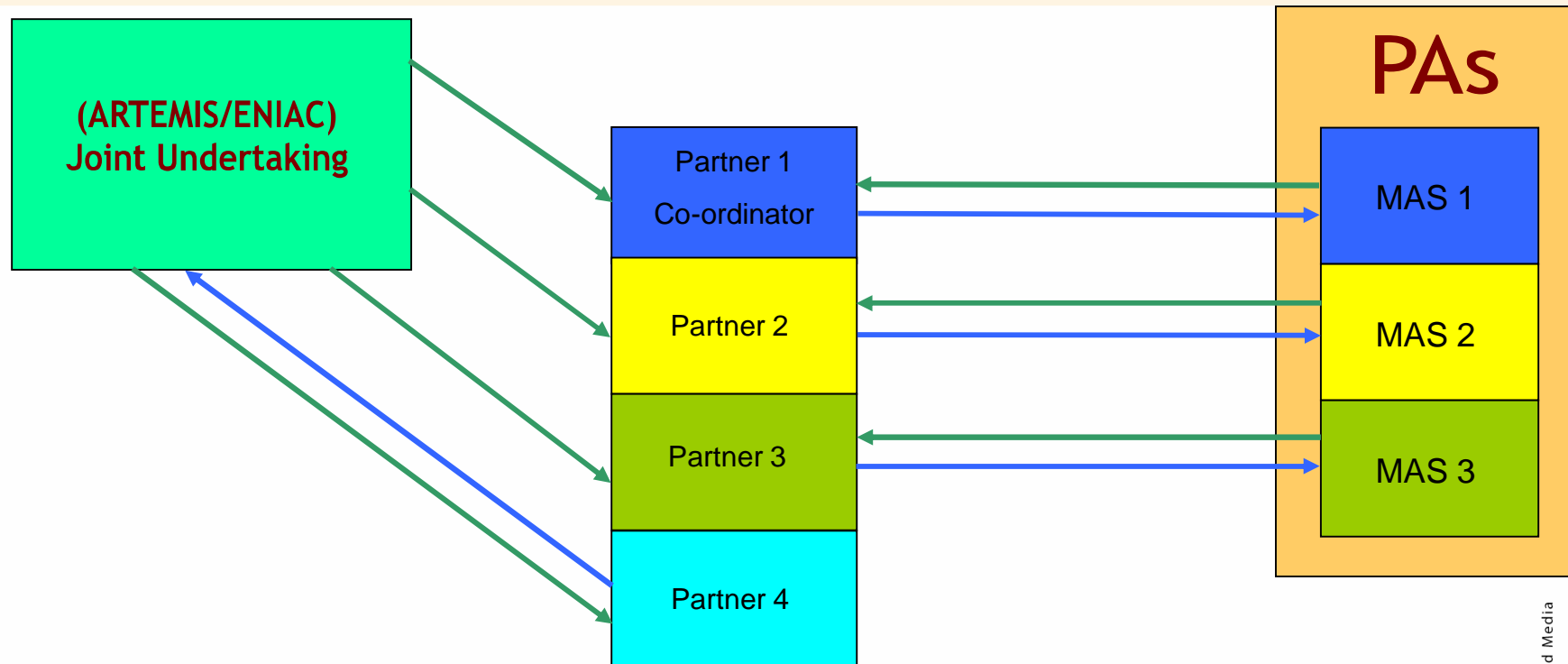
Specific conditions applicable to beneficiaries having concluded a corresponding national grant agreement- Annex IV (3)

Beneficiaries from ARTEMIS/ENIAC MS

- Interest yielded by pre-financing
According to the rules set by the respective NFA
- Suspension, termination, reduction, amendment of the JU grant agreement will also depend on the suspension, termination, reduction, amendment of the corresponding national grant agreement
