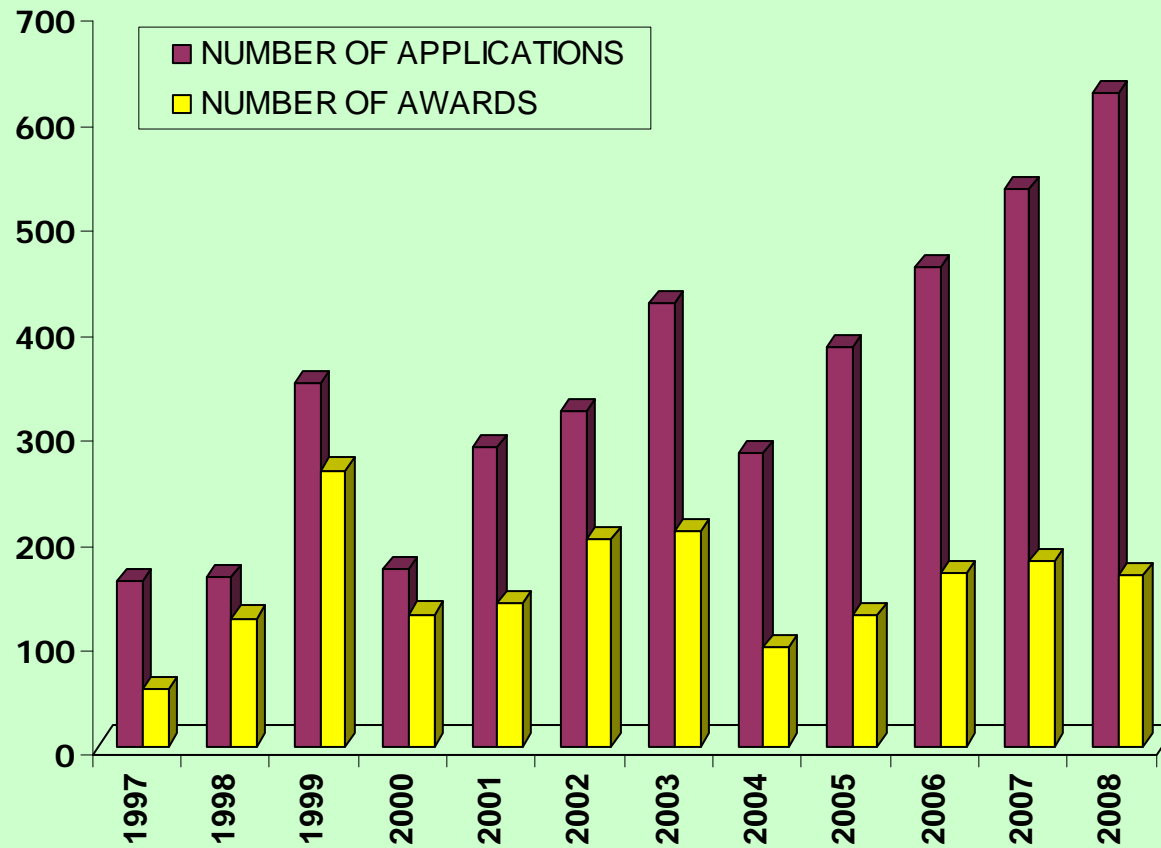
POSTDOCTORAL PROJECTS

- established in 1997 as „starting“ grant projects
- program for graduates of doctoral studies
- **Goal:**
 - more independence and visibility of young researchers
 - improve the financial situation (salary) of young researchers
 - support for participation in national and international conferences
 - learn to prepare a grant application and acquire skills for managing subsequent standard grants (for senior scientists)
- Main evaluation criteria:
 - quality, innovation, originality

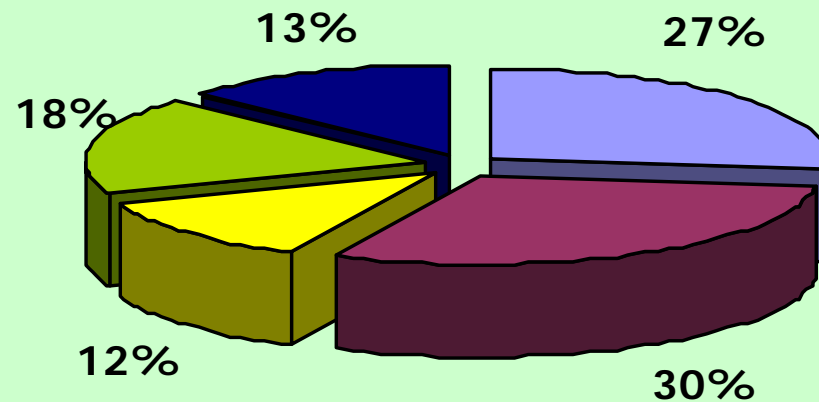
POSTDOCTORAL PROJECTS

- only **single** researcher projects
- submitted by a young investigator
- supervisor is not needed
- limited by the age of the applicant (35 years)
- only for applicants within 4 years following their PhD defense
- postdoctoral grant can be awarded only once
- deadline for application only in April
- project starts in January of the following year
- duration is a maximum of 3 years
- limited to a maximum cost of 40 000 Euro per award
